## MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING March 9, 2010

### Call to Order, Minutes and Agenda:

On Tuesday, March 9, 2010 at 9:00AM, Chairman Barbara Bailey called to order a regular meeting of the Danville Election Commission, with Commissioners Charles Bostic and Everett Laury and Executive Director Barbara Dreher also present. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed agenda of the meeting and also the minutes of the February 16, 2010 meeting.

### Accounts Payable:

The Board unanimously approved the payables report for February 9 through March 2, 2010, the largest item being an ES&S bill for ballots of \$7970.30. There will be a further primary election bill owed to ES&S, a bill for precinct kits, and a credit card bill owed to Chase for \$760.55 for truck rental and fuel and electric heaters used in the election.

### Voter Registration:

In February 2010 there were 245 registrations received at the Election Commission Office, of which 96 were received from the Secretary of State local office and 131 from the Public Aid Office. After rejecting 54 duplicate registrations, there were 121 new registrations accepted and 62 transfers accepted.

### AECOI Conference:

The May AECOI Conference in Danville was discussed, including programs and meals to be presented.

### Election Judges:

Democratic Party Chairman Greg Lietz and Republican Chairman Craig Golden will be contacted as to precincts that need election judges, with information as to new judges being sought by May. Classes for new judges are targeted for August and September.

### Election Dates:

Director Dreher mentioned that the first day for grace period registration and voting at the Election Commission Office is October 6, 2010. Also the first day for early voting is October 11, 2010, which also is a Columbus Day holiday.

### Adjournment:

The meeting was adjourned at 9:42AM, with the next regular meeting scheduled for 9:00AM on April 13, 2010.
