NOTICE TO ABSENTEE VOTERS

- Print clearly in ink. This form may **not** be submitted by e-mail or Fax.
- Any properly registered voter may vote absentee, either by mail or in person.
- Absentee ballots will be mailed upon receipt of an application, beginning February 24, 2011. The last day an absentee ballot can be mailed is March 31, 2011.
- In person absentee voting will be conducted from February 24 through April 4, 2011 in the Danville Election Commission office located on the 1st floor of the Courthouse Annex, 6 N Vermilion St in Danville.
- Ballots must be postmarked **before** April 5, 2011, and received no later than April 19, 2011, to be counted.
